A riper, full-bodied style of Sauvignon Blanc, from the Sound of White vineyard on Catalina Sounds' Waihopai Valley estate. This is a seriously refined and grown up NZ Sauvignon	
Domaine de la Motte Beauroy, Premier Cru Chablis, France	85
A rounded, fuller style of Chablis with aromas of buttered toast in addition to classic mineral tones, with toasty oak, fresh lemon and a slight creaminess on the palate. The finish is long and mineral with a hint of umami and salinity.	
Nuovo Quadro Gavi del Comune di Gavi, Italy (v)	55
A fine, single estate Gavi di Gavi from a 5 hectare plot on the La Battistina estate - textured and complex whilst retaining bright acidity.	
Carte Noire Picpoul de Pinet, France	49
On trend right now and a winner if you like Pinot Grigio and light, fresh and fruity whites. They drink this with Oysters and shellfish in the small fishing port of Pinet where the wine is from.	
Vallet Frères Pernand-Vergelesses, France (v) A beautiful White Burgundy. The wine has a golden colour with aromas of orchard fruit and toasty oak. Rich, complex flavours of baked apples, toasted hazelnuts and delicious vanilla oak.	130
Domaine du Pré Semelé Sancerre Les Chasseignes Sancerre, France The nose is redolent of ripe grapefruit, pear and white blossom. The palate is extremely refined and has an electrifying saline/mineral character that is beautifully taut and expertly balanced	110
by the lovely weight of bright citrus and softly herbal fruit. Exemplary.	
Fritz Willi Riesling Feinherb, Germany (v)	50
This is a classic German Riesling from the steep slopes of the Mosel Valley. It's slightly off-dry so has a touch of sweetness and has aromas of ripe apricot and lemon.	
Valmiñor Albariño, Spain (v)	63
An elegant style of Albariño driven by the coastal influence from the Atlantic, and from the Miño river which borders the region.

Nieto Don Nicanor Malbec, Argentina (v)		60
Brooding and intense. A classic Malbec from Nieto's premium Agrelo vineyards, with flavours reminiscent of those desert soils. Dark, dense complex nose with sweet cranberries, blackberries and rich mocha characters.		
Adobe Reserva Organic Pinot Noir, Chile (v)	10.5	42
Earthily aromatic with a bright wild strawberry appeal. Gentle notes of juniper and black pepper. With a palate reminiscent of red cherries and chocolate. A lovely light but serious wine from the pioneers of organic wine making in South America.		
Sierra Grande Merlot, Chile (v)	10	35
This is the type of Merlot you would want and expect from Chile. Juicy and fresh with soft red fruits and a hint of green pepper.		
Les Volets Malbec, France (v)	11	38
France is the original home of Malbec and it always packs in a bit more power due to the warmer climate and lower altitude. This is a medium to full bodied crowd-pleaser!		
Ontañón Rioja Crianza, Spain	11.5	48
An absolute go-to for your classic Rioja style, offering juicy bramble fruits and warm and rounded oak characters. Showing tremendous quality and purity.		
Ontañón Rioja Reserva, Spain		64
Reservas are only produced in years of exceptional quality - and from the most select vineyards. It's great to have the Crianza and Reserva on from the same producer, so maybe get a bottle of each and see what you think.		
Felline I Monili Primitivo, Italy (v)	11	44
Primitivo feels very on trend at the moment with people looking for the richer more opulent style of red. Although this red is unoaked, it doesn't disappoint with ripe red cherry notes and sweet spice.		
Borgia Garnacha, Spain (v)	9.5	32
A great way to start the reds. This wine always over delivers and wins multiple awards for its consistent style and quality. Medium bodied and full of bright red berry aromas. From just southeast of Rioja in Campo de Borja.		
MOKOblack Pinot Noir, New Zealand (v)		59
Moko refers to the Māori facial tattoos showing status and ability. This lovely Pinot Noir reveals a

RED

Alto Los Cuises Malbec, Argentina (v)

100% Malbec from El Porvenir's highest vineyard (1850 masl) situated in a ravine of the Sierra de Quilmes. Vines are immersed in an intimate environment of diverse vegetation, among palm trees, fig trees, white carob trees and a beautiful jacaranda tree. The grapes obtained from this vineyard have a character of wild herbs that are reflected in a unique wine, like the place where it comes from.

Château Carcanieux, Crus Bourgeois du Médoc, France

It's not just the label on this wine that makes you think you have a classy bottle of Bordeaux in front of you, you'll know when you open in and take the first sip. Ripe cassis fruit, oak spice and a leafy note to the ripe tannins.

Montresor Satinato, Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy (v)

An exceptional Amarone from one of the oldest wineries in Verona. Satinato means "frosted" like the bottle. This was done to protect the wine inside as the bottles were exported from Genoa to New York

Smalltown Vineyards The Black Craft Shiraz, Australia	57
A compelling, dark and rich chocolatey beast. This is a classic Barossa Shiraz with intense savoury flavours of thick blackberry compote, black pepper and typical iron-rich beefy flavours.	
Rippa Dorii Crianza Ribera del Duero, Spain (v)	53
Rippa Dorii is Latin for Ribera del Duero. Arguably the most on trend region of Spain right now. The region uses the same grapes as Rioja (Tempranillo) but the finished wine is more structured and powerful.	
Tenuta II Cascinone Rive, Barbera d'Asti Superiore, Italy (v)	65
If you're looking for something big and tasty but a little different then look no further. Classic barrique- aged Barbera d'Asti Superiore from the oldest vineyards of the II Cascinone estate.	
Château Mangot L'Autre Mangot, Saint-Emilion, France	115
A very new take on wine from a traditional region - this "other" cuvée has been aged in clay amphora with no added subpites. Aromas of red cherry with lightly peppery, berbal potes. The palate is hold and	

with no added sulphites. Aromas of red cherry with lightly peppery, herbal notes. The palate is bold and powerful with mouth coating tannins, red berry fruit, pepper and a fresh acidity that provides balance. The finish is long with mulberry notes to the end.

Poderi Colla Dardi le Rosé Bussia, Barolo, Italy (v)

This fine and classic, single vineyard, Barolo is a testament to the Colla family's Dardi le Rosé site on the slopes of the Bussia hill - one of the best for the production of full-bodied Barolo with the potential to age.

Monte Schiavo Sassaiolo, Organic Rosso Piceno, Italy (v)

A chunky, savoury, rich, dark-fruited and oak-aged Montepulciano and Sangiovese blend - from Monte Schiavo's prized, organically-farmed, Colle del Sole vineyard.
